One question we still get asked today - was there actually a shortage when people were panic buying petrol and diesel at the pumps? The main answer during that specific time is that the demand skyrocketed, and the industry had to dig deep to keep up with the new need for very quick distribution.

OIL BUGS

THE JERRY CAN: A SHORT HISTORY

Transporting fuel efficiently to/around battle zones has always been necessary in any war strategy. In World War 2, the Germans came up with a way to do this in what they called "Wehrmacht Kanisters." These canisters were brilliant in their simple design. They were cheap, with just two pieces of steel slotting together with a single weld. The funnel could be opened without a tool, and the spout allowed for a smooth pour. The design also allowed the cans to float, providing an all-terrain way to move either fuel or water to strategic places. A sympathiser leaked this secret design to the allied forces, and by VE day there were 21 million "Jerry cans" in circulation. As I'm sure you know the allied forces referred to the Germans as 'Jerrys'. They remain to this day the most popular way to correctly store small amounts of fuel.
